The meeting is about announcing the new program of studies which will increase the GPA and port-folio.

The AP subjects are available in Physics for 11th graders and Physics and Calculus for 12th graders.

The students who decide to take the course should reach the TOEFL

requirement of 475 or above. Also, the student's grade on Math and Science should be at least B.

The students who wish to study engineering in college are recommended to take the AP course, especially the one who planned to study the international program in both Thailand or abroad.

The application for Advanced Placement should be applied before the end of March.
